- b) Regarding community-owned housing, a further separate public consultation of the community will be required to take this forward.
- c) Parent Council and Wee Bogies to look into proposal for improving or expanding the play park facilities. Signposting for visitors also required at Craigie Avenue road end
- d) All abilities path mentioned as a priority but not included on list, as Community Company and Community Council are jointly proceeding with this already
- e) Group to reconvene to look at signage again in general in the village, but also to consider some of the points raised on this at the Big Conversation eg public toilets, parking for cycle shop users/walkers/steam train users, community hall, playing field, play park, possibility of football in road at Hall
